







# GFWC was founded in 1890 by Jane Cunningham Croly

"Is it possible that women may have a life of their own, may learn to know and honor each other, may find solace in companionship, and lose sight of small troubles in large aims?"






In 1868, Croly, an accomplished NY newspaperwoman, was denied admittance to a Banquet honoring Charles Dickens at the all-male New York Press Club, simply because she was a woman. Outraged, she formed the club "Sorosis" - derived from a botanical class of plants which bloom into fruits on one body, like a pineapple.

On April 24, 1890, 63 Clubs officially formed the General Federation of Women's Clubs (GFWC), with the motto, "Unity in Diversity"

Founded over 474 free Public Libraries 4,655 Traveling Libraries




Calaveras Big Trees State Park created in 1954


On Friday, March 1, GFWC Executive



**Information Flow Chart** 






